The Group focuses on manufacturing and sales of downstream photovoltaic modules in the photovoltaic industry. Based in China (the “PRC” or “Chinese Mainland”), its business footprint covers the global major photovoltaic markets, over 30 countries and regions around the globe. It is a big advantage in producing such products that the major customers of photovoltaic modules are large domestic state-owned enterprises, multinational corporations, and other photovoltaic end-user customers. The Group is also engaged in photovoltaic systems installation as well as developing, designing, constructing, operating, and maintaining photovoltaic power generation plants.

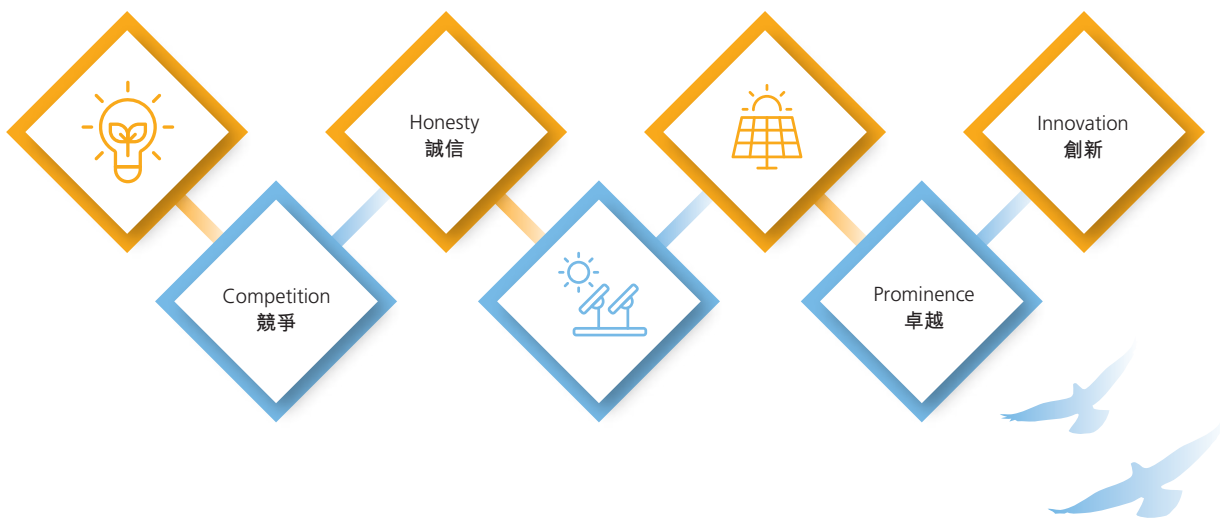

About the Report

This is the tenth Environmental, Social and Governance (“ESG”) Report (the “Report”) of the Group and is prepared in accordance with the Environmental, Social and Governance Reporting Code (the “ESG Reporting Code”) provided in Appendix C2 to Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “HKEX”).

This Report focuses on the sustainability-related policies, measures, and performance within our core business, which involves delivering solar energy services to midstream industries and end consumers. Its objectives are to enhance dialogue and collaboration with internal and external stakeholders, while underscoring our dedication to environmental stewardship.

Reporting Scope and Period

The Report covers the period from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025 (the “Reporting Period”).

Unless otherwise specified, the reporting scope of the Report is consistent with last year, covering the core business segments of the Group in Chinese Mainland as follows:

- i. the manufacture and trading of photovoltaic modules;
- ii. the construction and operation of photovoltaic power plants; and
- iii. the manufacture and trading of semiconductors, the trading of monocrystalline silicon solar cells and others.

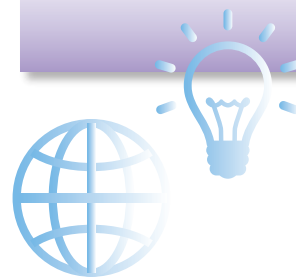

With ongoing communications with our stakeholders, the Group continually assesses and improves our long-term sustainability strategies to meet the expectations of our stakeholders. During the Reporting Period, the Group conducted an internal materiality assessment to identify and prioritize the ESG issues that were material to the Group's business operation and our stakeholders. The material ESG issue list of the Group was formulated in reference to the HKEX's regulatory requirements, the Materiality Map published by the Sustainability Accounting Standards Board ("SASB"), and material issues identified by the peer-listed companies in Hong Kong. After the consideration and assessment of the Company's management, we have identified a total of 23 material ESG issues, and there were 12 material ESG issues prioritized as the most important issues in this Report.

Emission Control

Aspect A1: Emissions

As the leading global photovoltaic manufacturer, the Group is steadily increasing its commitment to a more resource-efficient and environmentally sustainable production model through the adoption of innovative energy-saving and emission-reduction technologies. To uphold compliance with national standards for pollutant and waste discharge, the Group has set up the Environmental and Safety Department, which is responsible for overseeing and managing its eco-friendly facilities. In addition, a range of initiatives has been introduced to strengthen environmental performance across routine operations and broader business activities.

The Group strictly complies with relevant environmental laws and regulations in all operating countries and regions, including but not limited to the “Environmental Protection Law of the People’s Republic of China”, the “Law of the People’s Republic of China on Environmental Impact Assessment” and the “Law of the People’s Republic of China on Noise Pollution Prevention and Control”. We regularly monitor updates to these regulatory requirements. During the Reporting Period, the Group was not subject to any fines or litigation related to environmental pollution.

Air Pollutant Emissions Control

Air emissions include nitrogen oxides, sulphur oxides, particulate matter and other pollutants regulated under national laws and regulations. Pollutants are primarily emitted from the stationary combustion and mobile vehicle usage.

作為全球領先的光伏製造商，本集團正透過採用創新的節能減排技術，穩步增加對資源效率更高、更環保的生產模式的承諾。為確保符合國家污染物及廢物排放標準，本集團已成立環境及安全部，負責監督及管理其環保設施。此外，亦引入了一系列措施，以加強日常營運及更廣泛業務活動中的環保表現。

本集團嚴格遵守所有營運國家和地區的相關環境法律法規，包括但不限於《中華人民共和國環境保護法》、《中華人民共和國環境影響評價法》和《中華人民共和國噪聲污染防治法》。我們定期監控這些監管要求的更新。於報告期內，本集團並無受到任何與環境污染有關的罰款或訴訟。

The Group has a decrease in non-hazardous waste generation during the Reporting Period, primarily due to the reduction in production capacity. As a result of lower output, the amount of waste packaging materials, which constitute a significant portion of the Group's non-hazardous waste, has correspondingly diminished.

The Group prioritizes emission reduction and efficient waste management as part of its long-term targets, ensuring proper and standardized waste treatment is key to minimizing the environmental impact of its operations. Hazardous waste generated during production is handled by industry-qualified waste collectors, who manage the disposal and transfer of hazardous waste in full compliance with applicable regulations. Non-hazardous waste is sorted and temporarily stored in designated areas before disposal, with recyclable materials in good condition sold to external recycling parties to help reduce overall disposal volume.

本集團致力以減排及有效廢物管理為長遠目標，確保適當和標準化的廢棄物處理是將業務運營對環境影響降至最低的重中之重。至於生產過程中產生的有害廢棄物，本集團聘請具有行業資格的廢棄物收集商根據相關法規管理有害廢棄物的處置和轉置。無害廢棄物在處置前經過分類並適當存放在指定地點，狀況良好的可回收物料則出售給外部回收方，以盡量減少整體棄置量。

The Group adheres to sustainable development, recognizing that our resource-intensive business operations require comprehensive planning and implementation to minimize resource consumption from the environment. We strictly follow national, local and industry policies, regulations, and standards on energy conservation, such as the "Energy Conservation Law of the People's Republic of China". To achieve better resource efficiency comprehensively, we prioritize the conservation of energy, water, materials, and land while actively promoting a circular economy. Through stringent resource management, we ensure responsible usage across all business operations, effectively restraining and avoiding waste.

資源管理

層面A2：資源使用

本集團堅持可持續發展，認識到我們的資源密集型業務運營需要全面的規劃與實施，以盡量減少對環境資源的消耗。我們嚴格遵守國家、地方及行業關於節能的政策、法規與標準，如《中華人民共和國節約能源法》。為了全面提升資源使用效率，我們強調節約能源、水資源、材料及土地資源，並積極推動循環經濟。本集團嚴格管理資源使用情況，確保在所有業務運作中負責任地利用資源，並有效控制及避免浪費。

During the Reporting Period, the Group has had a significant reduction in the use of resources, including energy, water and packaging materials consumption. The majority is due to the reduction in production capacity, which has led to a decline in all sources of resource usage across various aspects of the Group's operations.

Energy Efficiency Management

The Group's direct energy consumption is primarily from fossil fuels used in stationary combustion for melting raw materials, usage of mobile vehicles and mobile equipment such as forklifts. Indirect energy is mainly purchased electricity for manufacturing operations at the Group's production plants. The purchased electricity is largely consumed by the production operations of modules.

Water Efficiency Management

Recognizing that photovoltaic manufacturing involves high water consumption, the Group is committed to the responsible use of water resources and has established this as a key objective for enhancing water efficiency. To oversee water consumption, the Group has established the “Prevailing Energy Management Regulations” and developed strategies aimed at reducing raw water use and enhancing water conservation efforts. Additionally, flowmeters have been fitted in our production plants to conduct regular monitoring and review the overall water usage.

The Group has made continual advancements in the techniques and equipment used for ultrapure water production to increase pure water output and reduce raw water consumption. The concentrated water produced by ultrapure water systems is repurposed for production needs.

Packaging Material Management

To meet the standard packaging requirements of most of our customers, the Group’s main packaging materials for finished solar panel modules are cardboard boxes, pallets, and plastic packing straps.

To reduce environmental impact and enhance operational efficiency, Jinzhou Yangguang Energy Co., Ltd. has implemented a sustainable change in its packaging material management. Specifically, the subsidiary pioneered the use of degradable molded pallets made from agricultural and forestry waste as a direct replacement for traditional wooden pallets. This switch to a biodegradable, waste-derived material not only reduces the company's reliance on timber but also brings significant logistical benefits. The new green packaging increases container utilization by over 30%, thereby lowering both transportation and warehousing costs. Notably, this single packaging innovation has already generated significant cost savings, demonstrating a successful integration of environmental responsibility with economic performance.

Environmental Impact Reduction

Aspect A3: The Environment and Natural Resources

According to an assessment conducted by the Environmental and Safety Department, the Group's operations do not have a significant impact on the environment and natural resources. To further mitigate any potential effects, the Group implements a range of environmental protection measures. These include the adoption of energy-efficient equipment to reduce energy use and minimize waste. For winter heating, circulating water systems have replaced coal-fired boilers, contributing to lower energy consumption. In addition, the Group's production facilities are equipped with sewage treatment stations, acid mist treatment towers, and purification towers, all of which help reduce energy usage, lower emissions, and lessen the impact of pollutants.

The Group was awarded the Three-Star Certification by the China Quality Certification Centre ("CQC") for "China Green Building Materials Products". We have taken practical actions to promote the wide application of Photovoltaic green building materials in buildings and accelerate the realization of "carbon peaking and carbon neutrality" goals in the building industry.

As a nationally recognized Green Factory and carbon neutrality pilot unit in Jiangsu Province, we have implemented comprehensive green initiatives across our operations. We have optimized production processes to incorporate environmentally friendly materials while strictly controlling resource consumption and emissions. Our green supply chain management ensures environmental responsibility across the entire industrial chain, meeting increasing global demands for sustainable products as regions implement “carbon tariffs”. We continue advancing our low-carbon initiatives across all business dimensions to enhance product sustainability while supporting global carbon neutrality objectives.

We are proud to announce our participation in the Food Wise Charter, a key initiative under the Food Wise Hong Kong Campaign launched by the Environmental Protection Department. As signatories, we commit to implementing measurable food waste reduction targets within our organization and promoting behavioural changes that foster respect for food resources. This commitment aligns with our broader environmental sustainability goals and demonstrates our dedication to responsible resource management.

Combat Climate Change

Part D: Climate-related Disclosures

As a manufacturer of photovoltaic modules and operator of photovoltaic power plants, we fully recognize that the growing global concern over climate change is profoundly reshaping our operating environment. This impact is evident not only in physical terms, such as the increasing intensity of heatwaves, extreme rainfall, and climate-related events affecting production facilities, supply chain stability, and the long-term weather resistance of our products, but also in the rapidly evolving regulatory landscape worldwide.

Amid intensifying global attention on climate issues, regulatory requirements across different jurisdictions continue to expand. In China, the pursuit of the “Dual Carbon” goals has become a key driver of industrial transformation, while in Hong Kong, the HKEX has progressively strengthened climate-related disclosure requirements for listed companies. These developments clearly indicate that addressing climate change is no longer merely a matter of policy advocacy. It has become a core operational priority that companies must proactively address.

In response, our Group has formulated a comprehensive low-carbon operational strategy and refined our internal management policies. These efforts are designed not only to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements but also to make a tangible contribution to the global transition toward carbon neutrality. We adopt a source-based approach by systematically managing carbon emissions, energy consumption, and related risks to minimize our environmental footprint. At the same time, we place strong emphasis on employee engagement, promoting sustainability principles through ongoing awareness campaigns and training programs that encourage the integration of these values into daily operations.

To enhance our capacity in addressing climate-related risks, the Group has developed a forward-looking governance and response framework. This framework is aligned with the recommendations of the Task Force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures (TCFD), the IFRS S2 framework issued by the International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB), and the disclosure requirements set out in HKEX’s Environmental, Social and Governance Reporting Code. For further details on how we address specific disclosure requirements, please refer to the “Content Index of the ESG Reporting Code” at the end of this report.

應對氣候變化

D部分：氣候相關披露

作為光伏組件製造商及光伏電站營運商，我們充分認識到全球對氣候變化的日益關注正深刻重塑我們的營運環境。這種影響不僅體現在實質層面，如日益強烈的熱浪、極端降雨及氣候相關事件影響生產設施、供應鏈穩定性及我們產品的長期耐候性，也體現在全球迅速演變的監管環境中。

隨著全球對氣候問題的關注度不斷提高，不同司法管轄區的監管要求亦不斷擴大。在中國，追求「雙碳」目標已成為產業轉型的主要驅動力，而在香港，聯交所亦逐步加強對上市公司的氣候相關披露要求。這些發展清楚表明，應對氣候變化不再僅僅是政策倡導的問題。它已成為企業必須主動應對的核心營運優先事項。

為此，本集團制定了全面的低碳營運策略，並完善了內部管理政策。這些努力不僅旨在確保符合監管要求，而且旨在為全球邁向碳中和的轉型作出實質貢獻。我們採用從源頭出發的方法，系統地管理碳排放、能源消耗和相關風險，以盡量減少我們的環境足跡。同時，我們非常重視員工參與，透過持續的意識宣傳活動和培訓計劃推廣可持續發展理念，鼓勵將這些價值觀融入日常營運中。

Governance

The Board holds the highest level of oversight responsibility for ESG and climate-related matters. It is responsible for formulating and regularly reviewing relevant strategies, policies, and targets, while integrating climate considerations into long-term business planning and investment decisions. To strengthen the Board's expertise in climate-related areas, we arranged specialized training sessions and established a mechanism for engaging professional advisors. The nomination and re-election processes for directors also include an assessment of their experience and capabilities in overseeing ESG and climate-related issues, where applicable. Together with ongoing professional development requirements, it is ensured that the Board maintains a robust understanding of these topics.

The Board oversees the Group's exposure to climate-related risks and opportunities, embedding them into the overall governance structure and aligning them closely with strategic planning and risk management processes. To ensure effective oversight, we have put in place systematic procedures to continuously monitor climate-related performance and progress.

At the operational level, there is a clear division of responsibilities between the Board and management. The Board approves policies and mechanisms for managing climate-related matters and ensures adequate resources are allocated. Management is responsible for day-to-day implementation and works closely with subsidiaries to drive the execution of various climate initiatives. Further information on the overall ESG governance structure can be found in the "Sustainability Governance" section.

管治

董事會對ESG及氣候相關事宜負有最高級別的監督責任。其負責制定及定期檢討相關策略、政策及目標，同時將氣候考量納入長期業務規劃及投資決策中。為加強董事會在氣候相關領域的專業知識，我們安排了專門的培訓課程，並建立了聘請專業顧問的機制。董事的提名及重選過程亦包括評估其在監督ESG及氣候相關議題方面的經驗與能力(如適用)。連同持續的專業發展要求，確保董事會對該等議題保持深入的了解。

For climate-related topics, including objectives for addressing risks and opportunities and the progress made, we mandate that reports be presented to Board meetings at least once a year. During the Reporting Period, climate matters were discussed at the management level. The Group also conducts regular reviews of these mechanisms and arrangements to ensure they remain aligned with evolving regulatory requirements and industry best practices, thereby fostering continuous improvement in both climate governance standards and performance.

Strategy and Risk Management

Climate Risk Assessment

The Group recognizes that climate change may introduce various risks and financial implications across different aspects of its business. In response, we systematically identify and evaluate climate-related risks in accordance with the recommended framework of the TCFD. This process involves examining both physical and transition risks to pinpoint climate-related issues that could materially affect our operations. Notably, ESG and climate-related risks associated with solar technology and project developers have been identified as emerging risks with long-term implications. We continuously monitor their potential financial consequences while actively exploring related opportunities.

策略及風險管理

氣候風險評估

本集團認識到氣候變化可能為其業務的不同層面帶來各種風險及財務影響。為此，我們根據TCFD的建議框架，系統地識別及評估氣候相關風險。該過程涉及審查實體風險及轉型風險，以準確找出可能對我們的營運產生重大影響的氣候相關議題。值得注意的是，與太陽能技術及項目發展商相關的ESG及氣候相關風險已被識別為具有長期影響的新興風險。我們持續監察其潛在的財務後果，同時積極探索相關機遇。

During the Reporting Period, we engaged professional advisors to conduct an in-depth analysis and carry out an initial assessment of business-related climate risks, incorporating industry benchmarking. In line with the relevant guidance from the HKEX and prevailing market practices, we categorize climate risks by time horizon: short-term (immediate and less than 5 years), medium-term (5 to 25 years), and long-term (over 25 years). The table below outlines the climate risks identified by the Group and their potential impacts:

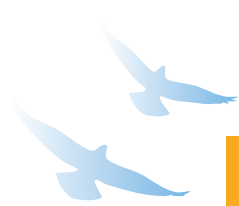

The Group is committed to advancing sustainable development through concrete actions, actively supporting projects that align with our corporate values and create positive social impact. During the Reporting Period, we supported Hong Kong's first community-initiated carbon-neutral concert, "Chill & Decarbonize: ESG Charity Concert"* , organized by Riskory S, a brand of Riskory. The event aimed to promote carbon neutrality for all, using music to reach a wider audience and unite the community to build a sustainable culture. At the same time, it supported local music development in Hong Kong to create a lasting, positive impact on the society. Circular economy principles were integrated throughout the planning and execution of the event, including the use of natural bamboo pulp tissues, reusable stainless-steel cutlery, the provision of craft beer upcycled from surplus bread, and comprehensive food waste recycling. A portion of the event's proceeds will be donated to Food Angel, reflecting Riskory S's commitment to food waste management and resource circularity, thereby amplifying the social impact.

With respect to the greenhouse gas ("GHG") emissions generated by the event, Riskory, a specialist in Carbon Neutral Event Management (CNEM), conducted a carbon audit, which was subsequently verified by an independent, globally recognized third-party testing and certification organization. To achieve carbon neutrality for the event, Riskory purchased and retired carbon credits via the HKEX Core Climate platform to offset the remaining emissions#. By supporting this project, we aim to play a demonstrative and catalytic role, fostering collaboration across the value chain and encouraging suppliers, business partners, and other stakeholders to jointly participate in Scope 3 emissions management, thereby laying a solid foundation for our long-term carbon reduction goals and working together to create a more sustainable future.

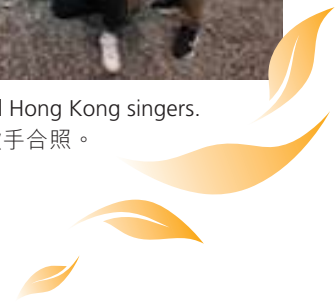

The Group offers competitive remuneration, promotion opportunities, compensation, and benefits packages to attract and retain talent. During the Reporting Period, the Company has been awarded as a Good MPF Employer, recognizing our commitment to providing a comprehensive and well-managed retirement benefits scheme for our employees. Salaries are reviewed regularly in reference to performance appraisals and market trends. 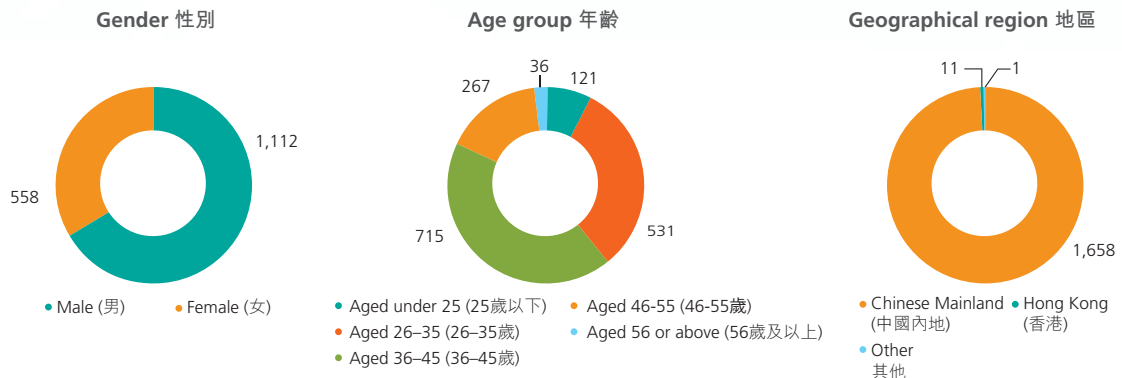

The Group is committed to providing employees with a safe and healthy working environment, as their health and safety remain our highest priority. We strictly comply with all relevant health and safety legislation, including but not limited to the “Law of the People’s Republic of China on the Prevention and Control of Occupational Diseases” and the “Fire Control Law of the People’s Republic of China”.

During the Reporting Period, the Group was not aware of any non-compliance issues that violated the laws and regulations regarding health and safety. The data related to the health and safety of the Group are presented as follows:

All employees are required to adhere to relevant health and safety codes and manuals. Regular inspections are conducted at production facilities, and qualified professionals are engaged to identify potential occupational health risks.

Health and Safety Measures for the Production Process

We are committed to heightening safety awareness among our workforce. New employees are provided with comprehensive health and safety training, such as three-level safety training and occupational health and safety training. The Group has provided safety training courses, such as “Safety Construction Training” and “Safety Emergency Response and Fire Safety Knowledge”, to employees, aimed at minimizing work-related injuries and preventing fatalities. Warning signs regarding occupational hazards were posted at prominent positions within the working area to improve the safety level within the plants. Employees are equipped with appropriate personal protective equipment, including safety shoes, masks, acid-proof gloves and boots, earplugs, insulation gloves, and boots for work. Pre-employment medical screenings and annual health check-ups tailored to specific job hazards were provided for employees, so we can notice early abnormalities, prevent workers from developing occupational diseases and evaluate the effectiveness of existing preventative measures.

Talent Training Management

Aspect B3: Development and Training

Skilled talent is the Group’s solid foundation for driving sustainable business growth. The Group demonstrates its commitment to employees by providing well-rounded and practical training opportunities. Customized learning modules are designed for different departments, focusing on areas such as corporate culture, workplace safety, legal compliance, and professional expertise. These programs aim to help employees cope with their business needs, boost their competencies, and foster continuous professional growth.

The Group also ensure the employees stay informed about the latest industry trends and regulatory changes, which is essential to our operations and their respective roles. We regularly evaluate our training programs to review their effectiveness and alignment with our business needs.

生產過程的健康和安全措施

Prevention of Child Labour and Forced Labour

Aspect B4: Labour Standards

The Group has adhered to relevant applicable laws and regulations in Chinese Mainland, including but not limited to the “Labour Law of the People’s Republic of China”, the “Labour Contract Law of the People’s Republic of China” and the “Provisions on the Prohibition of Using Child Labour”. During the Reporting Period, we identified no significant legal non-compliance that would adversely affect our operations, specifically regarding child or forced labour.

To foster a fair and respectful workplace, the Group strictly prohibits child labour and forced labour in its business operations. This commitment is clearly stated in our employment contracts. During recruitment, identity checks and qualification reviews are conducted to ensure compliance with employment laws. If any violation is discovered after hiring, the labour relationship is terminated immediately to safeguard the rights of both parties involved. The human resources department will also carry out a thorough investigation to prevent such incidents from recurring.

Supply Chain Management

Aspect B5: Supply Chain Management

The Group is committed to maintaining a well-managed supply chain to deliver high-quality products and services that not only fulfill but also surpass customer expectations. We foster enduring, close partnerships with most of our key suppliers and carry out ad hoc evaluations to ensure that their products consistently meet the standards required by our clients.

During the Reporting Period, the Group had a total of 40 major suppliers, all of which were based in Chinese Mainland (2024: 33 major suppliers from Chinese Mainland). These suppliers provided the Group with essential materials for the manufacture of photovoltaic modules, including welding ribbons, frames, glass, junction boxes, encapsulant films, silicone sealants, backsheets, and solar cells.

防止童工和強制勞工

層面B4：勞工準則

本集團遵守中國內地相關適用法律法規，包括但不限於《中華人民共和國勞動法》、《中華人民共和國勞動合同法》及《禁止使用童工規定》。在報告期內，我們沒有發現任何會對我們的運營產生不利影響的重大法律違規行為，特別是在童工或強制勞動方面。

為營造公平和尊重的職場環境，本集團嚴格禁止在業務運營中使用童工和強迫勞動。此承諾在我們的僱傭合同中已明確規定。在招聘過程中會進行身份驗證和資格審查，以確保符合僱傭法。如在招聘後發現任何違規行為，將立即終止勞動關係，以保障雙方的權益。人力資源部門亦會進行詳細的調查以避免相關事件再次發生。

供應鏈管理

層面B5：供應鏈管理

本集團致力有效地管理供應鏈，為客戶提供優質的產品和服務，以期滿足甚至超越客戶的期望。我們與大多數重要供應商保持密切、長期的合作夥伴關係，並進行了不定期的供應商評估，以確保其產品品質持續符合客戶的標準。

於報告期內，本集團共有40家主要供應商，全部來自中國內地(二零二四年：33家來自中國內地的主要供應商)。這些供應商為本集團生產光伏組件提供了關鍵材料，包括焊帶、邊框、玻璃、接線盒、封裝膜、矽膠密封劑、背板及太陽能電池片等。

New and Existing Suppliers Management

The Group has clear regulations on engaging new suppliers and evaluating existing suppliers based on the supplier management control procedures. Before engagement, the Group will review the company information, including but not limited to examining their business license, business and product details, production capacity, main customer groups, testing equipment, customer complaint managing procedures, material safety data sheet (“MSDS”), environmental safety related qualifications and other materials. After that, our technicians and environmental and safety personnel will conduct a site visit to validate the provided information and to gain insights into the suppliers’ operational and management systems.

The Group also conducts regular factory inspections and performance evaluations of existing suppliers. Once an existing supplier is found to have any inappropriate behavior in the production process or fail to meet our performance benchmarks, they receive formal notice. If the supplier does not take any restorative actions in time, the Group will cancel its supplier qualification. During the Reporting Period, all the major suppliers had been evaluated.

Sustainable Supply Chain Practices

In response to stakeholders’ concerns about the environmental and social impacts associated with our supply chain activities, such as raw materials sourcing and product distribution, the Group has implemented socially responsible and green procurement practices in response to the increasing focus on managing environmental and social risks in the supply chain.

For instance, our supplier agreement incorporates specific environmental requirements, and those who obtain reputable environmental-related certifications will be given priority as a consideration factor when selecting our potential suppliers. We will encourage the suppliers as well as their employees on green procurement and socially responsible sourcing, fostering a shared commitment to sustainability throughout our supply chain.

新增及現有的供應商管理

本集團對聘用新供應商以及根據供應商管理控制程式評估現有供應商有明確規定。在聘用前，本集團將審查公司資訊，包括但不限於審查其營業執照、業務及產品詳情、生產能力、主要客戶群體、檢測設備、客戶投訴管理程序、材料安全數據表 (MSDS)、環境安全相關資質等材料。之後，我們的技術人員、環境和安全人員將進行實地考察，以驗證所提供的資訊，並深入了解供應商的運營和管理系統。

本集團亦定期對現有供應商進行工廠檢查及績效評估。一旦發現現有供應商在生產過程中有任何不當行為或未能達到我們的績效標準，他們就會收到正式通知。如供應商未及時採取任何恢復措施，本集團將取消其供應商資格。於報告期間內，我們已經對所有主要供應商進行評估。

可持續供應鏈實踐

為回應持份者對供應鏈活動(例如原材料採購及產品分銷)對環境及社會影響的關注，本集團已推行社會責任及綠色採購措施，以應對供應鏈中環境及社會風險管理的日益重視。

例如，我們的供應商協定包含特定的環境要求，在選擇我們的潛在供應商時，那些獲得信譽良好的環境相關認證的人將被優先考慮作為考慮因素。我們將鼓勵供應商及其員工進行綠色採購和對社會負責的採購，促進我們整個供應鏈對可持續發展的共同承諾。

Product and Service Quality Control

Aspect B6: Product Responsibility

The Group prioritizes customer satisfaction and loyalty, ensuring this through rigorous quality control at every stage of production. Procedures and policies are established to govern all sorts of claims and complaints. The Group adheres to complying with the laws and regulations related to health and safety, advertising, labelling, and privacy matters relating to products and services provided and methods of redress, including but not limited to the “Patent Law of the People’s Republic of China” and the “Copyright Law of the People’s Republic of China”. We were not aware of any material non-compliance issues that violated the relevant laws and regulations during the Reporting Period.

Quality Assurance

The Group’s Quality Control Department conducts routine quality inspections, verifying that our products meet customer specifications and quality benchmarks. The Group always puts “Guaranteeing Product Quality” in the first place. For any returns or exchanges due to product defects, the Quality Control Department will re-inspect the returned products and take the appropriate course of action based on the cause of the defective products. During the Reporting Period, 0.0001% (2024: 0.0004%) of sold or shipped products were recalled due to safety and health reasons.

After several years of unremitting efforts by the Group, our international advanced testing capabilities have been strictly integrated into the production and production of modules. The continuous enhancement of testing capabilities and strict implementation of these standards have elevated the quality of our components. In 2022, we obtained the laboratory accreditation certificate (Certificate No.: CNAS L16766) issued by China National Accreditation Service for Conformity Assessment (the “CNAS”), demonstrating that our Photovoltaic Testing Center has officially entered the nationally recognized international laboratory team.

In 2024, our GIGA series modules earned three major certifications from leading authorities: VDE’s IEC 61215/61730 new standard certification for single and double-glass modules, TÜV Rheinland’s equivalent certification, and China Testing & Certification International Group Co., Ltd (“CTC”) Best Quality Award for outdoor verification. Later, Chint Group honored us with the “Quality Management Excellence Award” at their 2024 Supplier Conference, recognizing us as an Advanced Supplier among numerous candidates.

產品和服務質量控制

層面B6：產品責任

本集團將客戶滿意度和忠誠度放在首位，通過在生產的每個階段進行嚴格的品質控制來確保這一點。制定了程式和政策來管理各種索賠和投訴。本集團堅持遵守與所提供產品和服務及補救方法有關的健康與安全、廣告、標籤及隱私事宜相關的法律法規，包括但不限於《中華人民共和國專利法》和《中華人民共和國著作權法》。在報告期內，我們沒有發現任何違反相關法律法規的重大不合規問題。

質量檢定

本集團的品質控制部門進行例行質量檢查，以驗證我們的產品是否符合客戶的規格和品質基準。本集團始終把「產品質量保證」放在首位。對於因產品缺陷而導致的任何退貨或換貨，品質控制部門將對退回的產品進行重新檢查，並根據缺陷產品的原因採取適當的措施。在報告期內，共有0.0001%（二零二四年：0.0004%）的已售或已運送產品因安全和健康原因召回。

經過本集團多年來的不懈努力，我們的國際先進檢測能力已嚴格融入模組的生產與製造過程中。隨著檢測能力的不斷提升以及對相關標準的嚴格執行，我們組件的品質亦得以進一步提升。於二零二二年，我們獲得由中國合格評定國家認可委員會（「CNAS」）頒發的實驗室認可證書（證書編號：CNAS L16766），標誌著我們的光伏檢測中心已正式進入國家認可的國際實驗室團隊。

在二零二四年，我們的GIGA系列組件榮獲三項權威機構頒發的主要認證，包括VDE依據IEC 61215/61730新標準頒發的單玻與雙玻組件認證、TÜV萊因的同等認證，以及中國國檢測試控股集团（CTC）頒發的戶外驗證「最佳品質獎」。此外，在正泰集團二零二四年供應商大會上，我們獲頒「品質管理卓越獎」，被評為眾多供應商中的優秀供應商之一。

Our photovoltaic modules undergo testing at 5-10 times the severity of IEC standards, demonstrating exceptional performance through advanced technology and mature manufacturing processes. We've established a comprehensive quality management system spanning from raw material procurement to production, strictly adhering to international standards to ensure every module meets our rigorous quality benchmarks.

During the Reporting Period, the Group obtained three key UL certifications for its 2000V photovoltaic modules and junction boxes (UL 61730, UL 61215, and UL 3730). These certifications from UL Solutions, a globally recognized safety science leader, confirm that our high-voltage products have successfully passed rigorous international safety and performance standards.

Over the years, the Group has strictly controlled product quality, with a quality control system that covers the entire production process and traceability, consistently ranking at the forefront of the industry in terms of quality.

Customer Service and Complaints Management

We prioritize customer feedback as a driving force for the continuous improvement of our products and services. Upon receiving any complaint, we act promptly to address the issue and implement effective corrective measures. Our Quality Control Department holds regular discussions and reviews to prevent recurrence of similar incidents. During the Reporting Period, there were a total 8 cases of complaints (2024: 29 cases) received by the Group, and all were properly handled. In addition, the Group was not aware of any other material complaint or damage claim on safety and health reasons related to our product and service quality from our clients.

Privacy Protection

The Group acknowledges the privacy protection of individuals and business data to strengthen mutual trust with our clients. We have formulated a relevant policy that only authorized personnel from relevant departments are permitted to collect, access, and manage confidential and sensitive information. All employees are prohibited from making copies or disclosing confidential information to third parties without prior approval from management or clients.

我們的光伏組件經受遠高於IEC標準5至10倍強度的測試，透過先進技術及成熟的製造工藝，展現出卓越的性能。我們已建立一套涵蓋從原材料採購至生產製造的完整品質管理體系，嚴格遵循國際標準，確保每一片組件皆符合我們嚴格的品質基準。

於報告期內，本集團的2000V光伏組件及接線盒獲得了三項關鍵的UL認證(UL 61730、UL 61215及UL 3730)。這些來自全球公認的安全科學領導者UL Solutions的認證，證實了我們的高電壓產品已成功通過嚴格的國際安全及性能標準。

多年以來，本集團始終嚴格把控產品品質，建立覆蓋整個生產流程與可追溯機制的品質控制系統，在品質方面穩居行業領先地位。

客戶服務及投訴管理

我們重視客戶的反饋，以此作為不斷提升我們產品和服務的動力。一旦收到任何投訴，我們將迅速採取行動解決問題，並實施有效的糾正措施。我們的品質控制部亦會定期進行討論及檢討，以防止同類事件再次發生。報告期內，本集團接獲共8宗投訴(二零二四年：29宗)，所有投訴已妥善處理。此外，本集團並不知悉因產品的安全與健康原因及服務質量引起的重大客戶投訴或損害索賠。

私隱保障

本集團重視保護個人及業務資料的私隱，以加強與客戶的互信。我們制定了相關政策，只有相關部門的授權人員才能收集、訪問和管理機密和敏感資料。未經管理層或客戶事先批准，禁止所有員工複製或向第三方披露機密資料。

Protection of Intellectual Property

Intellectual property is an essential asset to the Group, and we maintain a zero-tolerance policy towards infringement upon the intellectual rights of others. Also, the Group raises employees' awareness of intellectual property protection through internal publicity and employee training from time to time.

Upholding the Business Ethics in the Workplace

Aspect B7: Anti-corruption

The Group is committed to achieving the highest possible fairness, openness, and integrity standards. We strictly comply with the laws and regulations, including but not limited to the "Anti-Unfair Competition Law of the People's Republic of China", the "Anti-Money Laundering Law of the People's Republic of China" and the "Criminal Law of the People's Republic of China". During the Reporting Period, the Group was not aware of any case of breaching the relevant laws and regulations relating to corruption, bribery, extortion, fraud, or money laundering, nor did it conclude legal cases regarding corrupt practices brought against the Group or our employees.

The Group rigorously enforces operating procedures and codes of conduct to uphold ethical standards among employees. They are required to disclose any potential conflicts of interest. To prevent corruption involving the supply chain and business partners, we incorporate a clause into all transaction contracts explicitly prohibiting suppliers from offering any form of direct or indirect benefits to the Group. Additionally, we mandate that suppliers, construction units, and relevant project personnel sign an integrity declaration.

To further combat fraud and prevent corruption occur within the Group, we have established a whistle-blowing policy to allow our stakeholders to report any suspected corruption or unethical behaviors. Whistleblowers would be assured of fair treatment, including protection against unfair dismissal and victimization and their identity would be kept confidential.

In recognition of the importance of ongoing education in preventing corruption, the Group is contemplating the introduction of anti-corruption training provided to directors and all employees. This initiative aims to reinforce the understanding of ethical standards and legal compliance, fostering a culture of integrity across all levels of the organization.

為進一步打擊欺詐行為及防止本集團內部發生貪污行為，我們制定了舉報政策，允許持份者舉報任何涉嫌貪污或不道德行為。舉報人將得到公平對待，包括防止不公平解僱和傷害，他們的身份將被保密。

本集團認識到持續教育在預防貪污方面的重要性。因此正在考慮為董事和所有員工提供反貪污培訓。此舉旨在加強他們對道德標準和法律合規的理解，在組織的各個層面培養誠信文化。
